

The Margaret Chalmers Memorial Scholarship 2017

REGULATIONS

- 1. The Margaret Chalmers Memorial Scholarship is to enable study in Australia or abroad, by a student of any instrument or voice.
- 2. The Scholarship is established by means of a bequest to the Music Teachers' Association of New South Wales Ltd by the late Margaret Chalmers.
- 3. The Scholarship is open to only to students of **FINANCIAL MEMBERS** of the Music Teachers' Association of NSW.
- 4. A Scholarship totalling \$6,000 will be awarded in 2017 of which \$3,000 will be awarded for the winner of the Instrumental Section, and \$3000 for the winner of the Vocal Section.
- 5. To be eligible for this Scholarship, applicants may not be older than 25 years of age, as at 30th June, 2017 and have been a resident of NSW for the greater part of his or her life including 4 out of the last 6 years.
- 6. Previous winners of the Margaret Chalmers Memorial Scholarship are ineligible to enter.
- 7. All auditions must be submitted by either CD, USB, or DVD. **THREE** copies of the works presented must be submitted with entry, for the adjudicators.
- 8. Two contrasting works should be presented. Total time limit for entire performance is ten (10) minutes. **THREE** copies of the works being presented must be submitted with entry, for the adjudicators.
- 9. Finalists will be required to perform the same works in the Showcase Concert, as those presented for the audition.
- 10. The decision of the adjudicators is final and the awarding of any prize shall be at their discretion.
- 11. Entries will not be accepted unless accompanied by an entry fee of \$45.00 for students of financial members of the Association.
- 12. Finalists will be required to perform at a Showcase Concert later in the year.
