

The 2017 Elizabeth Todd Lieder Prize in Memory of Geoffrey Parsons

REGULATIONS

- 1. The Elizabeth Todd Lieder Prize in Memory of Geoffrey Parsons is open to the singing students of both members and non-members of the Music Teachers' Association of NSW Ltd.
- 2. Both singer and pianist will be judged conjointly on their performance, including appropriate dress sense, if selected as a finalist.
- 3. Two works of contrasting styles must be performed from the works of Schumann, Brahms, Wolf, Strauss, Mahler or Schubert.
- 4. The songs must be performed in the German language.
- 5. All auditions must be submitted by either CD, USB or DVD. **THREE** copies of the works being presented should be submitted with entry, for the adjudicators.
- 6. Total time limit for entire performance is ten (10) minutes.
- 7. Entrants must be aged under 35 years as at 30th June 2017.
- 8. Previous winners of The Elizabeth Todd Lieder Prize in Memory of Geoffrey Parsons are ineligible to enter.
- 9. The decision of the adjudicators is final and the awarding of any prize shall be at their discretion.
- 10. Finalists will be required to perform the same works in the Showcase Concert, as those presented for the audition.
- 11. The award for the 2017 Elizabeth Todd Lieder Prize in Memory of Geoffrey Parsons is the sum of Fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) to be shared equally between singer and pianist (i.e. \$750.00 each)
- 12. Entries will not be accepted unless accompanied by an entry fee of \$45.00 for students of members of the Association and \$55 for the students of non-members.
- 13. Finalists will be required to perform at a Showcase Concert to be held later in the vear.
