Julie Spithill has for many years, taught jazz techniques to classical trained pianists (and emerging jazz pianists), both at the Conservatorium of Music Sydney and in her private studio.

Jazz musicians would say, "Some cats in our combo are coming to a jam session to try out their chops on a happening chart that has some cool riffs."



Topics covered will include modes -and how to use them; chords and extensions; chord progressions; analysing a jazz lead sheet and basic improvisation techniques.

Come armed with questions - or send them along in advance – there will be ample time for discussion and lots of handouts to assist with creative ideas and practical issues.
