

Terence Koo is an Australian jazz pianist, composer, lecturer, teacher and recording artist. Terence holds a Master of Arts (Music), a Bachelor of Music (First Class Honours), the University medal, an A.Mus.A., and a number of University scholarships & prizes. In 2017 Terence was awarded the University of Newcastle Faculty of Education and Arts Dean's Award for Teaching Excellence and Contribution to Student Learning.
